Twenty years ago Chicago's historic Montgomery Ward catalog building was redeveloped into an office development known as 600 West Chicago. Now under Sterling Bay ownership, the building has been transformed into an innovative and attractive retail, commerce, and office destination. An expanded retail experience, including Amazon Go, Farehouse Market and Bián modernized tenant amenities, and a world-class designed, newly revamped ground floor eliminate the need for a huge tenant base of the 8-story, 1.65M SF building to venture anywhere else for their needs.



The four retail suites totaling 25,321 USF and divisible to 2,257 USF were previously occupied by an office user making this a rare opportunity for a retail brand to call 600W Chicago home. The retail spaces front Larabee with exposure to Chicago Ave and are located between two new retail co-tenants, Bián (private wellness club) and Farehouse Market (a new food market located in the building lobby).

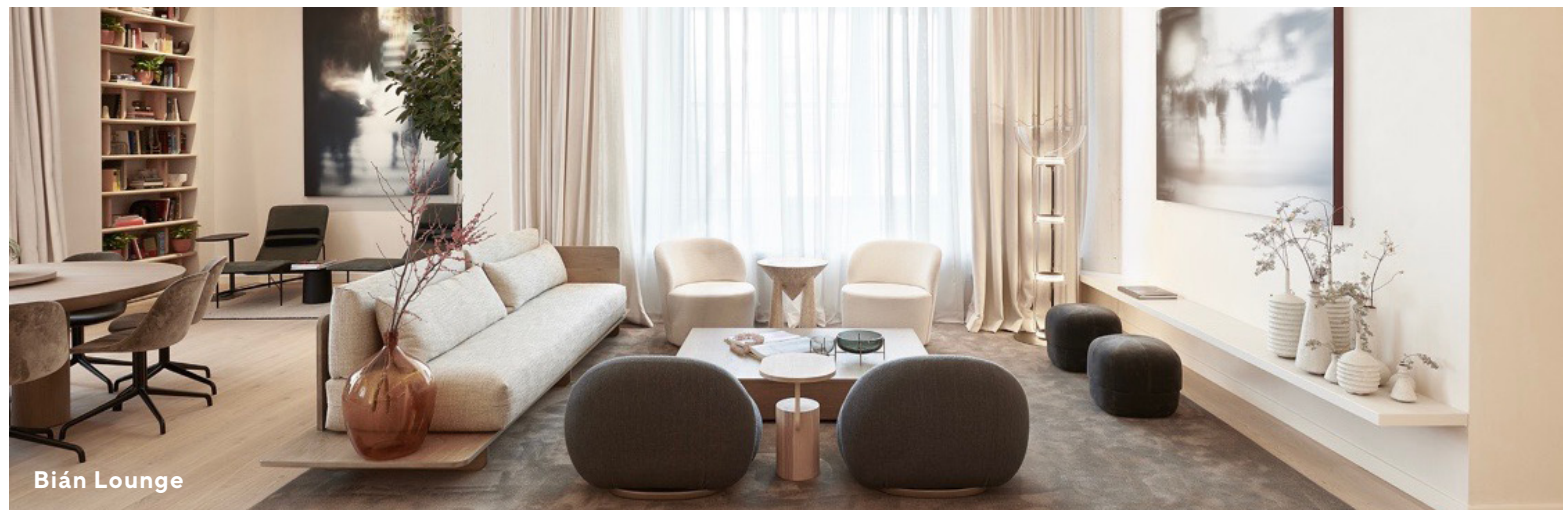

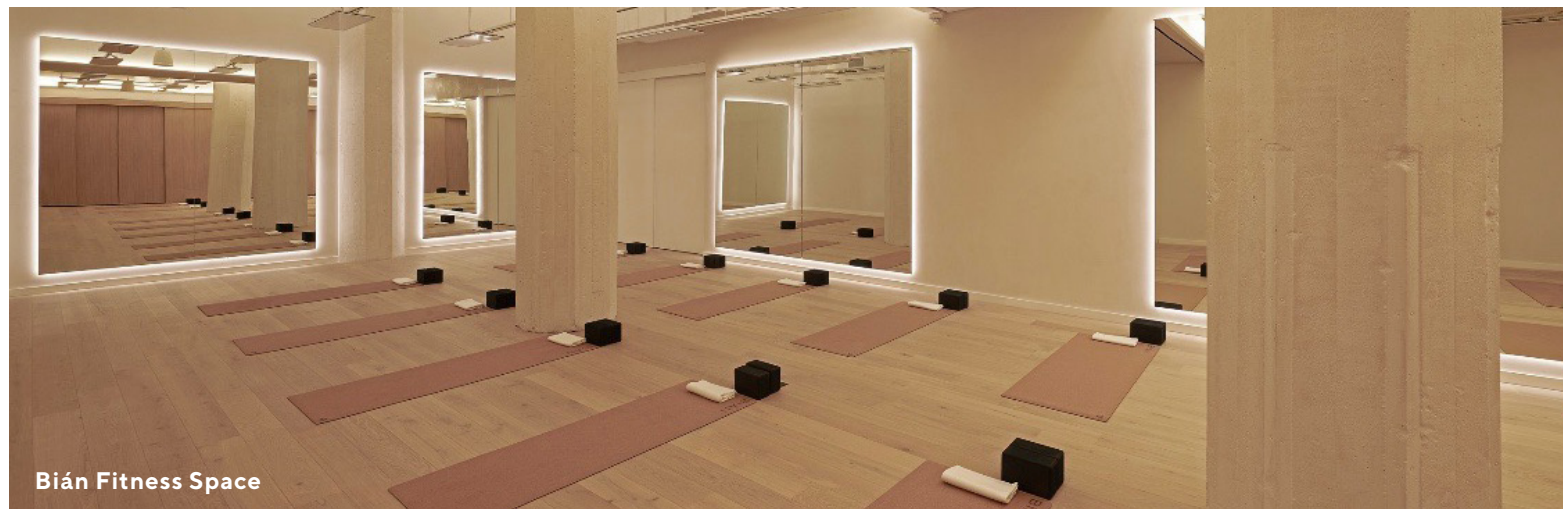

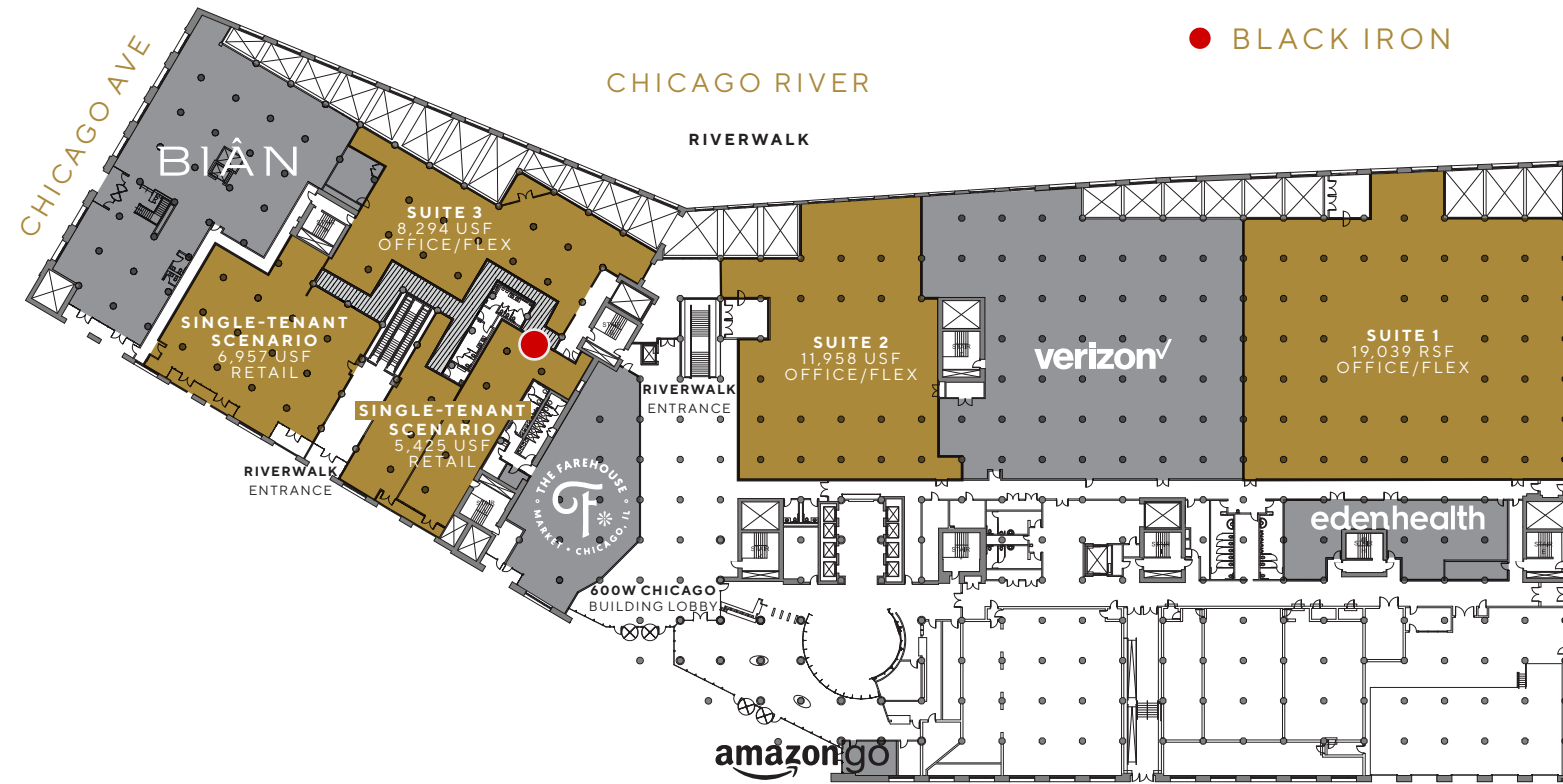
